09/10/237 COMPLAINT BY MR. D. WRIGHT OF MALADMINISTRATION IN RESPECT OF UNTRUE, DAMAGING AND DEFAMATORY MATERIAL CONTAINED IN A RECENT INVESTIGATION REPORT

Pursuant to Minute No. 09/10/205 of September, 2009, the Clerk reported that, as the District Council had refused to hear his complaint under the formal Complaints Procedure, he had proceeded to complain directly to the Local Government Ombudsman. The Clerk again stressed that the complaint was not related in any way to the person the subject of the investigation report, but related to the author of the report.

The Clerk also reported that he had submitted a formal complaint to Councillor Quigley, Leader of Bassetlaw District Council, that the formal Complaints Procedure was being abused insofar as legitimate complaints were being blocked by officers.
